Monique Wittig (French: ; July 13, 1935 – January 3, 2003) was a French author and feminist theorist who wrote about overcoming socially enforced gender roles and who coined the phrase "heterosexual contract". She published her first novel, *L'Opoponax*, in 1964. Her second novel, *Les Guérillères* (1969), was a landmark in lesbian feminism.
